New to the Show: In an effort to support all fine arts, we are welcoming various local Fine Artists to participate in our show.

REGISTERED EGG ART GUESTS: This badge allows you to participate in: seminars, early entrance to the showroom and (replacing the Midnight Madness) "Faberge 'n Canapes", fee \$50. Join your eggging friends Saturday for an afternoon of food, eggging & fun! A light meal of 'finger foods' will be 3:30pm – 4:15pm. Then break away for THREE (3) fun projects taught by Russ Hagen, Maria Avneri and Diana Macias from 4:30pm – 7:30pm. Pre-registration is required with a deadline date of March 15th, space is limited.

AIRPORT: The Sacramento International Airport, approximately 26 miles to the hotels and 29 mi to the SES Hall. A variety of ride share companies are available. If you know of someone else flying into Sacramento, consider coordinating arrival times to share the cost of a ride. I will maintain a list of those who are flying in for those interested.

HOTEL RESERVATIONS: The show is **not** at a hotel but Elk Grove has several hotels within 3 miles and just minutes from the SES Hall. As a courtesy for our show participants, I have booked a block of 18 rooms - 3 Kings and 15 Queens w/2beds (the block rate cut off date: 3/12/24 or until sold out)

TABLE REGISTRATION: Tables will not be reserved without full payment. Make checks payable to Diana Macias. Table fee is nonrefundable. Electrical Hook-ups are limited: **You must supply your own extension cords, power strips and painters tape (not duct tape)**. All cords must be taped down.

Solid props, which cannot be seen through, may not be higher than 18". See through props must not be over 28" except on wall space. All supplies/ boxes etc. will need to be stored under your tables or in your vehicles. All tables are 8'x30 and will be draped with black tablecloths. **Egg Art dealers and exhibitors must display a minimum of (12) decorated eggs at their table.** Please indicate on the registration form the name to be displayed on your table sign.

- **DEALER TABLE (\$100 - 8'x30"):** Defined as those selling eggging supplies, materials, tools, etc. pertaining to eggs and your personal decorated eggs. Dealer with 1 table, no free assistants. Dealer with 2-3 Tables (1 free assistant), with 4 or more Tables (2 free assistants)

THIS IS AN ART SHOW TO PROMOTE EGG AND FINE ART IN THE HOPE OF INSPIRING THE PUBLIC TO BECOME INTERESTED IN THE ART. TO BE FAIR TO ALL DEALERS SUPPORTING AND PARTICIPATING IN THE EGG ART SHOW. PLEASE LIMIT THE "SHOW SPECIALS" TO NO MORE THAN 10% OF YOUR TABLES.**

- **EXHIBITOR / ARTIST TABLE (\$60): Registered Egg Art Guest Fees are not included.** Defined as those displaying and/or selling only decorated eggs, made by you, from genuine eggshells or other artwork. No egg kits, patterns or supplies may be sold. If you sell anything other than decorated real eggs or your own art, you must register as a Dealer. One assistant is allowed at \$8.
- **SET UP TIME:** On Friday, dealers with 3 or more tables 9:00am- 4:30pm. Dealers may set up 9:00am- 4:30pm and Exhibitors may set up 11am-4:30pm. No one other than table participants will be allowed in the showroom. The showroom will be opened Saturday and Sunday mornings at 8:30am for last minute set-up before the show opens at 9am.

TAX INFORMATION: Sacramento County & the City of Elk Grove taxes apply. To obtain forms contact: State Board of Equalization, at www.boe.ca.gov or (800) 400- 7115 or for a temporary seller's permit. State residents should contact their local Franchise Tax Board.

SECURITY: The SES Hall and Diana Macias assume no liability for loss or damage. Please help us by monitoring the activities in the showroom. There will be security on site throughout the event hours. The showroom will be closed, secured and no one will be allowed in at the end of each day.

LEARNING TABLE: The learning table will be available on Saturday and Sunday from 11:00am – 1:00pm. The projects are geared to adults and children who want to create an egg art project. There is a \$5 fee of which a portion will be donated to the Shriners.

CHARITY: Proceeds from the show raffle and the Learning Table Kits benefit the 'Shriners Hospital for Children in Sacramento - Prosthetics'. The Shriners provide hospitalization, treatment and transportation for children in dire need. Egg Art designs donated by various artists will be raffled on Sunday at 2:00p.m. You do not need to be present to win but will be required to pick up prize by 4pm on Sunday afternoon. I will demonstrate how to make the cold porcelain flowers as yours will be done and ready to arrange in a vase. We will work together on the hat, umbrella, and all lace dress (you will do very little sewing). This project most likely will be finished in class.

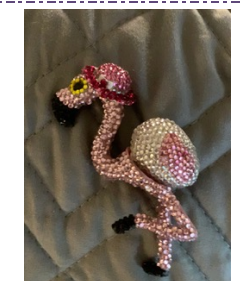

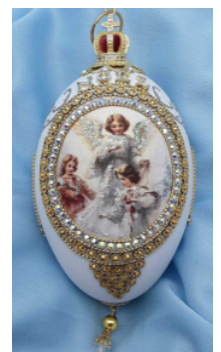

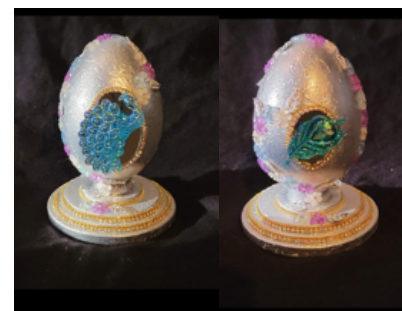

Permanent marking pen with extra fine point
Small curved cuticle scissors
Small sharp straight scissors for cutting paper

Tablet or notebook & pen for taking notes
Old hand towel to work on
Foam sponge to cradle egg
Container to take your eggs home
Flush cutters to cut rhinestone chain
Epoxy glue (Devcon 5 min. epoxy)
Mod Podge Clear or Matte
1 pair each – small round nose and small flat pliers
Long handled tweezers
White tacky glue in a small ultra fine tipped bottle
Regular Tacky Glue or Aleene's Fast Grab
